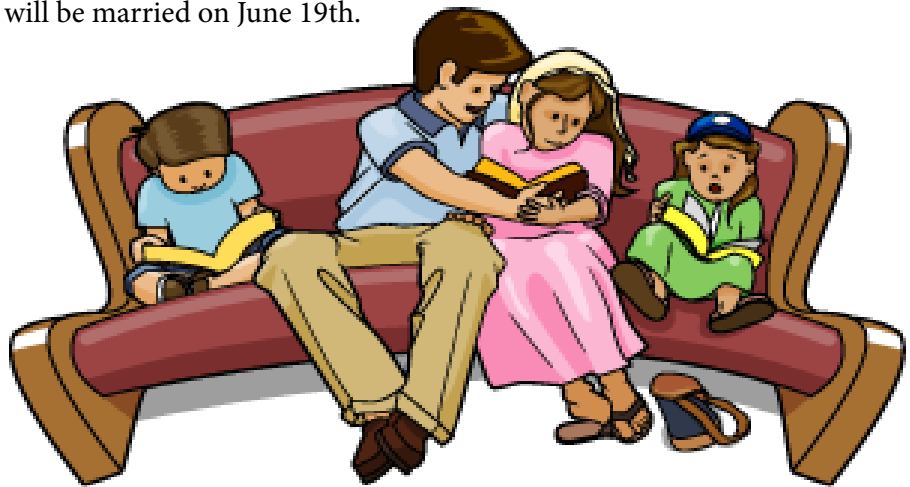
## Staff-Parish Relations Committee News

## Love for Lauren Results

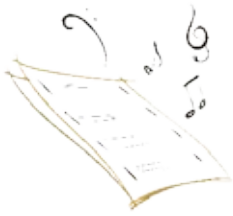

## Something AWE-some is Coming!

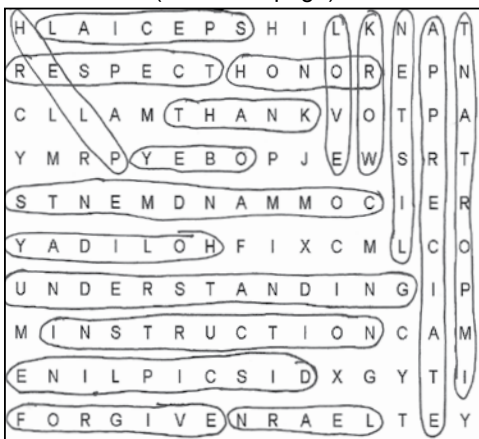
